Danmarks Nationalbank's guest apartments at Nyhavn 18

Today Danmarks Nationalbank sent a letter to the principals of the institutions of higher education as well as to the Danish Councils for Independent Research and the Danish National Research Foundation requesting applications for residence at the guest apartments at Nyhavn 18. The letter reads as follows:

As in previous years applications are invited for residence in the guest apartments made available by the Nationalbank to highly qualified foreign scientists and artists. We kindly request you to communicate the offer of guest apartments in 2012-2013 to all departments and institutes of your educational establishment as soon as possible.

The guest apartments are situated in Danmarks Nationalbank's property at Nyhavn 18. The apartments are primarily for scientists and artists staying in Denmark for a longer period of time. Normally the apartments are allocated for a period of minimum 3 months and maximum 1 year. The apartments are fully furnished and are made available free of charge.

Below is a list of the guest apartments and the dates on which they become vacant.

The guest apartments are allocated by Danmarks Nationalbank via a committee of 3 members which makes recommendations of the allocation of the guest apartments. The committee will meet in March 2012 to make recommendations on applications for the allocation of guest apartments until the summer of 2013.

Should your institution or staff wish to propose scientists and artists to be taken into consideration on allocation of the apartments your application should be submitted to the chairman of the committee, Professor, dr.med. Søren-Peter Olesen, c/o Danmarks Nationalbank, the Secretariat, Havnegade 5, DK-1093 Copenhagen K., or email to sekretariat@nationalbanken.dk, **no later than 25 January 2012.**

The application must be accompanied by a CV as well as a statement of the purpose of the visit to Denmark, a brief description of the project, the applicant's career and scientific production and of how the visit will be financed. Please also state whether the applicant is alone or accompanied by a spouse or children. Please state any alternative periods of residence with a view to optimum allocation of the apartments.
